### What is changing with Fidelis Insurance Group?

Fidelis Insurance Group has announced our intention to rebrand as Pelagos Insurance Capital. This marks a new chapter for our company, with a refreshed identity that better reflects our growth, expertise, and strategic vision.

### Why is the company changing its name?

Our evolution as a strategic capital allocator and risk selector in specialty insurance and reinsurance has led us to adopt a brand that more accurately represents our global network, lasting partnerships, and ability to navigate complex risks.

The Pelagos Insurance Capital brand identity, which we expect to launch in May, provides greater clarity for our people, our clients, and our shareholders, highlighting our unique market presence, and reinforcing our commitment to building lasting partnerships and meaningful connections.

### When will the name change take effect?

The transition to Pelagos Insurance Capital is expected on May 11, 2026, subject to legal and regulatory approvals. At that time, we will also begin trading under our new NYSE ticker symbol: NYSE: PLGO, and launch our new website. Throughout 2026, our various businesses and legal entities will also adopt the Pelagos Insurance Capital name, subject to obtaining all necessary approvals.

### What does “Pelagos” mean?



Pelagos comes from the root of the word “archipelago”, a community of islands, each unique yet connected and working together. It reflects how we’re built, a global community of teams, locations, and trading partners, each bringing distinct expertise and made stronger by the connections between us.

### How does Pelagos Insurance Capital differ from the previous structure?

Our business priorities, organizational structure, and strategic focus remain the same. The new brand is simply a stronger expression of who we are today, with no changes to our operations or relationships.

### How does the rebranding impact our partners, brokers, and clients?

Our operations and the way we conduct business will remain unchanged throughout and after the rebranding. All existing policies, contracts, and relationships will continue without interruption.

In addition, there will be no changes to any arrangements with our underwriting partners. The way business is conducted with our brokers and partners will remain unchanged throughout and after the rebranding process. Any functional changes, such as updates to underwriting stamps, will be communicated in advance to ensure a smooth transition.

### Will my existing policies, contracts, or account details be affected?

No, your existing policies, contracts, arrangements and relationships will continue without interruption. Unless we expressly notify you otherwise, all contact details, account information, and service arrangements remain in effect. Our team, underwriting expertise, and commitment to your success are unchanged. ### How are in-progress quotes, placements and/or renewal conversations and documents being handled during the transition to the new company name?

The upcoming change is limited to our company names and branding. There will be no change to the companies within Fidelis Insurance Group, other than the legal names of the companies. You will continue to do business with the same companies within Fidelis Insurance Group without interruption.

For any existing quotes, placements and/or renewal conversations and documents in progress before the name change takes effect, the relevant existing Fidelis Insurance Group company name, along with current stamps and documentation, will continue to be used. After the name change takes effect, all policies, contractual documentation and stamps will reference Pelagos Insurance Capital, and the specific relevant legal name. Once the name change is effective, we will write to you to communicate the new legal names.

From the effective date of the name change, all policies will be bound under the new name. This will not impact any existing quotes, placements or renewal conversations, other than to reflect the new name and brand identity.
